



Appeals Procedures

1. In the case of a club appealing a decision made by the Clubs Executive regarding funding, they may appeal to the Clubs Executive committee who may revisit the funding request at their discretion. There is no higher authority for funding decisions than the Clubs Executive.
2. In the case of the Clubs Executive taking disciplinary action against a club, up to and including the suspension of the club and rescinding of affiliation of the club as a UCC Club, the club may appeal to the Clubs Executive in the first instance. The Clubs Executive will arrange to hear the appeal. In the case of the decision standing, the club in question may bring a final appeal to the Academic Council for Student Experience.
3. In the case of a suspended or expelled club member appealing the decision, the appeal may be heard by the Clubs Executive in the first instance who may choose to overturn the decision. In the case of the decision standing, the person in question may bring a final appeal to the Academic Council for Student Experience.
4. In the case of a decision being made by the Campus Watch Committee or Disciplinary Committee, the appeal should follow the procedure outlined in the Student Rules.
5. In the case of a decision being made by a Club Committee, this can be appealed to the Clubs Executive.
6. Where a decision is made by the Department of Sport and Physical Activity, the club or person may bring an appeal to the Office of Student Experience.

7. In all cases, an appeal must be made within two weeks of notice of the decision being made. In the case of there being more than one appeal option, the initial appeal must be made within two weeks of the decision being made. If the decision is not overturned, a subsequent appeal may be made within two weeks of notice of the decision made at the initial appeal.
